



A few updates for the 2020 Virtual Pierce County Fair

Premiums will be offered for the 2020 Virtual Pierce County Fair. If you would like to support the Pierce County Fair, there is a question as you enter FairEntry that asks if you would like to donate your premiums back to the fair.

Posters are due tomorrow night by 10:00PM. To enter your poster, take a picture of your poster and upload it into FairEntry. You may enter up to 4 posters total. You may enter posters in projects that are enrolled. You may also enter a 4-H promotion and a general safety poster. You will also need to upload a [Poster Information Form](#) for each poster.

Showmanship is not required for members to enter other entries in animal departments. Members are encouraged to enter type classes or other specialty classes added for 2020.

Virtual Herdsmanship is open to all members enrolled in an animal project. Entries can be made for each animal project enrolled in. Members need to upload a photo of the member with their animal along with a statement that includes the following:

- Introduction with first name, club name, and years in 4-H
- A little about your animal
- A little about your experience in 4-H

Virtual Fun Fair entries are eligible to be entered in the Virtual Pierce County Fair. The only restriction is that members must be enrolled in the project they are entering in. If you entered a photo and not enrolled in the photography project, you may not enter the photo in the 4-H photography department. If you are in an animal project, check your department Fair Guide section as most barns have classes for creative arts and photography. You are also able to enter photos or artwork in open photography or open expressive arts.
