#### State 4-H Livestock Judging Contest

The 2020 State Livestock Judging Contest will be held virtually on October 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Members who are interested may apply to be on the state livestock judging team by emailing [kim.baker@wsu.edu](mailto:kim.baker@wsu.edu) by midnight on Tuesday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Your email **must include your first and last name, email address, age on 10/1/19, and best contact information for you.**

Kim will compile a list of interested parties to pass along to Livestock Judging Coach Marlin Newhouse. Marlin will contact interested parties to explain the next steps in determining the state team.

Some additional information you may find helpful in deciding if you are interested in this opportunity:

- The contest will be virtual and runs from 10 am to Noon. Reasons must be submitted by 2 pm.
- We can register 10 Intermediates and 10 Seniors for this competition.
- Youth will judge six livestock classes and give 3 sets of oral reasons, to be submitted via YouTube.
- Very specific instructions for oral reasons will be provided to you.
- If you have concern about connectivity or do not have resources available to you to participate virtually, let us know so we can help!

#### County-Level Record Book Judging

**Update!** This year, there will be an exception to the requirement that record books be evaluated at the club level before submitting them. If club leaders have scored record books, that is appreciated. If not, and if a member believes their record book would score at least 80, the record book may be submitted for an initial round of evaluation by other volunteers and/or staff.

Deadline: October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020, for ALL record books, including horse program  
Record books may be brought or sent to the county Extension office at 600 128<sup>th</sup> St. SE, Everett, WA 98208. *The office is closed to the public, except by appointment. Watch for a SignUp Genius to claim a drop-off time in next week's CloverGram.*

Because scoresheet revisions are not yet complete, each entrant may choose which scoresheet they wish to be used, if they have a preference. Simply include the preferred scoresheet in the front of the record book.
